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Are You Listening? is an online advocacy campaign organized by the **More** Than Brides Alliance. It highlighted the impact of COVID-19 on adolescent girls and brought attention to the absence of their voices from the pandemic response. The campaign highlighted the impact on girls through three topics: education, sexual and reproductive health and rights, and gender-based violence.

Initially started in the summer of 2020, the Are You Listening? campaign was revived during the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence. Throughout the 16 Days, we collaborated with Girls Not Brides to share stories of girls, supportive men and boys, and key partner staff. Overall, our campaign reached I.I million people on social media!

Along with our campaign, we had a Call to Action to demand policymakers put girls at the centre of the COVID-19 response and accelerate their efforts to end child marriage. I 02 organizations and I 83 individuals signed it!

The causes of child marriage are diverse and context-specific. However, one consis-



tently powerful driver across contexts is **gender inequality**, especially concerning norms related to the sexuality of adolescent girls. However, these causes of child marriage are insufficiently addressed, documented, and exchanged in child marriage programming.

From I-4 March, the More Than Brides Alliance is hosting an International Learning Event with girls, researchers, practitioners, and policymakers across 9 countries.

Building on the lessons learned from research evidence and implementation experi-

ence, together we will **Learn & Exchange** about the link between child marriage and sexuality, Reflect on how programmatic approaches and interventions can better address the sexuality-related drivers of child marriage, and *Prepare to Act!* on individual and collective levels to better address these drivers.
